6. From which book of the Bible is the Gospel reading?

Does Jesus tell his friends that following Him will be easy?

What does He say they should expect?

7. What is the name of our current pope?

8. The Catholic Church has held a total of 21 ecumenical councils. These councils are called by the pope to bring all the bishops in the world together to discuss important issues and to clarify Church teaching. What was the name of the last ecumenical council? (It lasted from 1962 to 1965.)
