

<p>What did the servant owe the king?</p> <p>(A great deal of money.)</p>	<p>Could the servant pay his debt to the king?</p> <p>(No)</p>
<p>Since the servant could not pay his debt, what did the king command to be done?</p> <p>(The servant's land and property would be sold and that he and his family would be sold as slaves in order to settle the debt.)</p>	<p>Because the servant could not pay his debt to the king, what did the servant do?</p> <p>(The servant fell down and worshipped the king, and begged him to have patience with him, promising to pay it all.)</p>
<p>The king was moved with compassion with his servant who begged for forgiveness. What did the king do then?</p> <p>(He released him from bondage and forgave the entire debt.)</p>	<p>When the servant found someone who owed him money, what did he do?</p> <p>(He grabbed the servant by the throat and told him that he must pay what he owed.)</p>
<p>Since the person could not pay the servant the money that he owed, what did the servant do?</p> <p>(He did not show him mercy and he had the person thrown into prison.)</p>	<p>What did the king do when he heard what his servant had done to the person who owed him money? (He had the unforgiving servant arrested, thrown into prison and tortured until the original debt was repaid.)</p>
<p>Will God forgive us when we do wrong if we are truly sorry for our sins?</p> <p>(Yes)</p>	<p>True or False: To be forgiven we must forgive others so God will forgive us.</p> <p>(True)</p>

<p>When should we tell God that we are sorry?</p> <p>(When we do something wrong.)</p>	<p>God forgives the wrong things we have done. What should we do to others who have done something wrong?</p> <p>(Forgive them.)</p>
<p>How many times must we forgive others?</p> <p>(We should forgive over and over again just like God and Jesus.)</p>	<p>When someone says they are sorry and they really mean it, what should you say?</p> <p>(I forgive you.)</p>
<p>What does it mean when you say, "I'm sorry?"</p> <p>(I feel bad about what I did to you, I wish I hadn't done it, I'm apologizing for what I did wrong, etc.)</p>	<p>What do we mean when we say, "I forgive you"?</p> <p>(You excuse/forgive somebody for a mistake or for doing something wrong.)</p>
<p>True or False: When you forgive someone for doing something bad you should do something mean back to him/her.</p> <p>(False)</p>	<p>True or False: When you forgive someone for doing something bad you should not be mad at that person any more.</p> <p>(True)</p>
