<p>What did Jacob give Joseph?</p> <p>(A wonderful coat.)</p>	<p>How did the brothers feel after Joseph received the gift?</p> <p>(They were jealous and hated Joseph.)</p>
<p>What did the brothers do to Joseph?</p> <p>(They put Joseph in a pit and sold him to some merchants as a slave.)</p>	<p>What did the brothers tell their father what happened to Joseph?</p> <p>(The brothers put goat's blood on Joseph's coat and told him that he was dead.)</p>
<p>Where did the merchants take Joseph and what did they do with him?</p> <p>(Joseph was taken to Egypt and sold as a slave to Potiphar, the captain of the King's guard.)</p>	<p>Potiphar's wife told a lie about Joseph and Potiphar became angry and did what to Joseph?</p> <p>(Put him into prison.)</p>
<p>What did Joseph do in the prison for two years?</p> <p>(Joseph was very good at telling people what their dreams meant and he explained the other prisoners' dreams to them.)</p>	<p>The king had a strange dream and Joseph was brought to him. What did Joseph tell the king what his dreams meant?</p> <p>(For 7 years there will be good harvest with lots of food for everyone, but then there will be 7 years when the harvest would be bad and many people will be hungry, even starving.)</p>

<p>The king was so pleased with Joseph that he did what to him?</p> <p>(He put Joseph in charge of all the stores of food in Egypt.)</p>	<p>What did Joseph do when he was governor?</p> <p>(Joseph made sure the extra grain from the seven years of good harvest was stored away.)</p>
<p>What happened after seven years of good harvest?</p> <p>(Harvest was very bad for 7 years.)</p>	<p>Jacob sent ten sons to Egypt to buy grain. Benjamin was left behind at home. The brother's asked the governor if they could buy food. Did they recognize Joseph? (No)</p>
<p>What did Joseph tell his brothers when they came to buy grain the first time? (That he would sell them the grain, but when they come again, they must bring Benjamin with them.)</p>	<p>Which brother did Joseph keep there in Egypt until the brothers came back?</p> <p>(Simeon)</p>
<p>What happened on the way home from Egypt to the brothers?</p> <p>(The brothers open their sacks of grain they had bought and found the money they had paid to Joseph. They thought they were being punished for selling Joseph.)</p>	<p>Who put the money in the grain sacks that the brothers took home?</p> <p>(Joseph told his servants to put it there.)</p>
<p>When the brothers came back to buy more grain they brought Benjamin. What did Joseph do? (He sold them more grain and ordered his servants to give them a meal.)</p>	<p>On their way home, Joseph's guards caught up with the brothers and open the sacks of grain. What did they find in one of their sacks?</p> <p>(Joseph's silver cup.)</p>

<p>Who hid the cup in the sack? (Joseph had told his guards to hide it there.)</p>	<p>Why was the cup hidden there? (Joseph wanted to test his brothers.)</p>
<p>The guards brought the brothers back to Joseph after finding the cup. What did Joseph do? (Told the brothers that they could go home, but they had to leave Benjamin there with him.)</p>	<p>What did the brothers do when Joseph said to leave Benjamin behind? (Begged Joseph to let them take Benjamin with them. Their father had already lost one son and if he loses Benjamin it would break his heart.)</p>
<p>Instead of leaving Benjamin behind, who did the brothers want to leave? (Another brother.)</p>	<p>How did Joseph know that his brothers had changed and were sorry for what they had done to him long ago? (That they did not want to leave Benjamin behind and wanted to let another take his place.)</p>
<p>What did Joseph do when he found out that his brothers were really sorry for what they had done? (He told his brothers who he really was. He also told them to go back and get their father and families and live with him.)</p>	<p>Whose sack had the cup inside? (Benjamin)</p>
