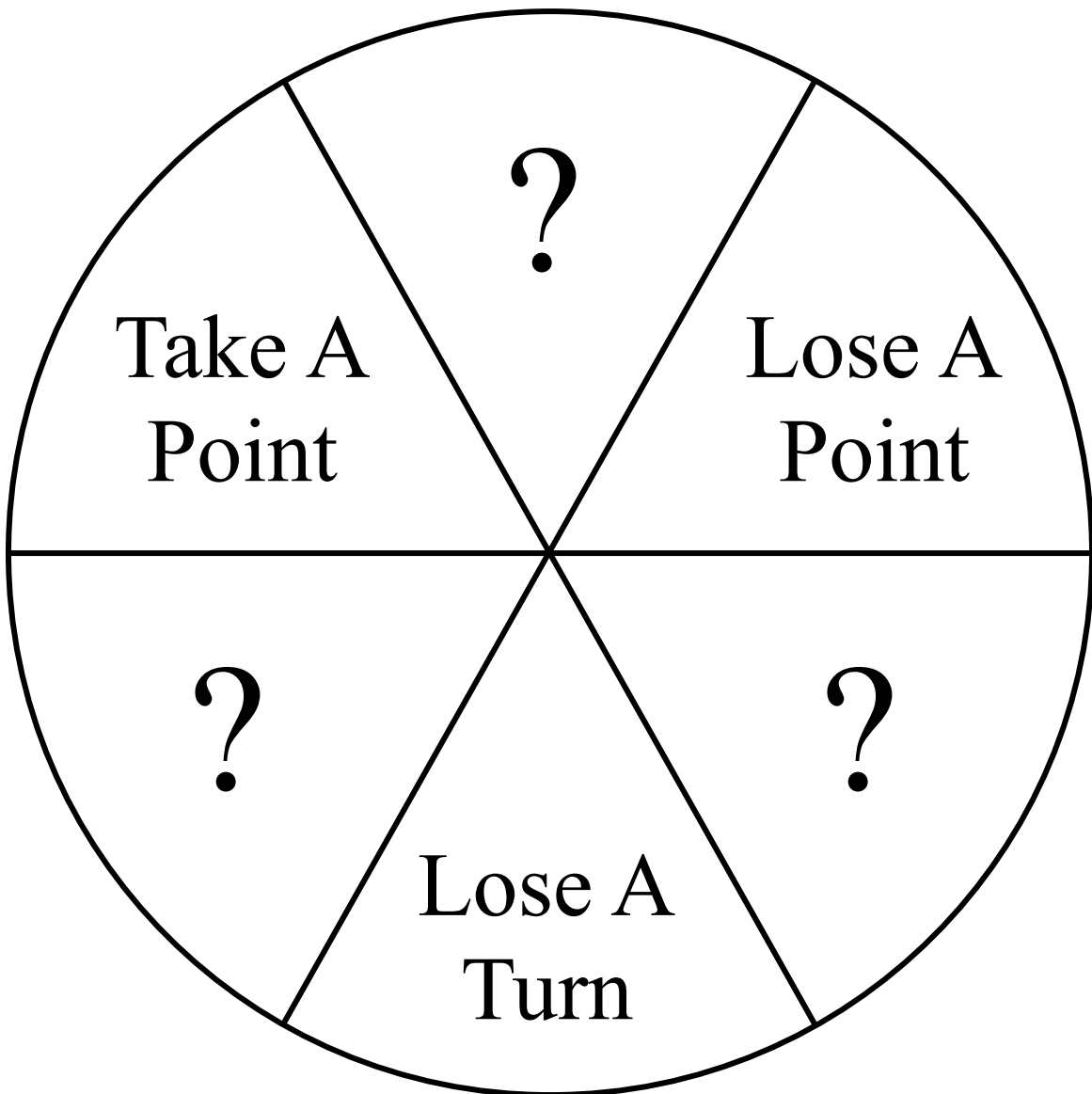


## Road to Emmaus Game

Luke 24:13-35

Materials needed: chalk board or dry erase board, suction cup ball that sticks to the chalk board or dry erase board, minute timer (you can get them at the dollar store), chair, small basket, chalk or dry erase board marker, Question Cards, Bibles

Directions: Have students read Luke 24:13-35 carefully. Review if necessary. Put Bibles aside. Put Questions Cards in a small basket. Draw on the board the chart below:



Divide the class into at least 3 teams. Write each team's name on the board so you can keep score. Place the chair several feet from the board. Have a player from one team stand behind the chair and throw the suction cup ball at the board. Where ever it sticks, the team has to follow the directions. If the suction cup ball misses the chart or does not stick, their turn is forfeited. If the suction cup ball sticks on "Lose A Point" the team loses a point. If the suction cup ball sticks on "Take A Point" they may take a point from any team they choose. If the suction cup ball sticks on "?" the team player draws a Question Card from the basket and reads it out loud. The teacher then turns over the minute timer while the team ponders the question. If they answer the question correctly before the minute timer runs out, they receive a point and it is written on the board. If they are not correct, they do not receive a point. The next team takes their turn (each player on the team must take their turn throwing the suction cup ball) and so on. The game continues until all the Question Cards are gone. The team with the most points wins.

#### Options-

1. Students can use Bibles to help them answer the questions.
2. The next team may answer the question if the first team cannot. If they answer the question correctly in one minute, they receive the point and then it is their turn to throw the suction cup ball.
3. Using Bibles, the team will have to answer the question AND cite the verse number where the answer comes from. They will receive 2 points if they can do both. The team will receive one point if they can only answer one part of the question correctly.

(Questions from: The New American Bible)

How many miles was Emmaus from Jerusalem? Luke 24:13 (Seven)

What village were the two disciples going to that very day? Luke 24:13 (Emmaus)

What were the two disciples talking about on their way to the village? Luke 24:14 (All the things that had happened to Jesus in Jerusalem.)

On their way to the village, who joined the two disciples? Luke 24:15 (Jesus)

But their \_\_\_\_\_ were prevented from recognizing him. Luke 24:16 (eyes)

What did Jesus ask the two disciples when he first joined them? Luke 24:17 (He asked them what they were talking about.)

What was finally opened so that the disciples could recognize Jesus? Luke 24:31 (Their eyes.)

What happened when they finally recognized Jesus? Luke 24:31 (Jesus vanished from their sight.)

“Were not our hearts burning [within us] while he spoke to us on the way and opened the \_\_\_\_\_ to us?” Luke 24:32 (scriptures)

Where did the disciples go after they recognized Jesus? Luke 24:33 (Back to Jerusalem.)

Who did they find in Jerusalem so they could tell them what happened? Luke 24:33 (The rest of the disciples and whoever was with them.)

Who had truly been raised? Luke 24:34 (The Lord.)

Who recounted what had taken place on the way and how he was made known to them? Luke 24:35 (The two disciples.)
