Worksheet for ages 11 to 14 years old

1. What day is it, today, in the Church's calendar?
2. What color is Father wearing?
3. Which version of the Penitential Rite did you say, today? ("I confess to Almighty God," or "Lord, have mercy," or "Kyrie, eleison.")

4. From which book of the Bible is the first reading?

What did Peter tell the Jewish people?

How did they respond?

5. From which Psalm is the Responsorial?

What is this Psalm about, in your own words?

This may be the most well-known Psalm of the Bible. Try to memorize the first line, this week. (*The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.*)

6. From which book of the Bible is the second reading?

Reread this passage, and put your name in it, as though St. Peter is writing directly to you. What is the lesson he wants to teach you?

7. From which book of the Bible is the Gospel reading?

Jesus used the analogy of sheep because it was a very familiar topic to all of the people to whom He spoke. How would you re-word the main point of this reading so that kids your age could understand it?

8. Before you go to sleep, tonight, tell Jesus all about your day!
