Liturgical Seasons/Colors

Ordinary Time – Green

Lent/Advent – Purple with 1 week of rose in each season

Christmas/Easter – White or Gold

Triduum – Red

Different feast days also have different colors: Virgins – white, Martyrs – red, Pentecost – red
